rrd-fs – description of the file system monitoring graphs

DESCRIPTION

The *fs.xml* file in the **rrdmon** package describes a couple of data channels retrieved from the operating system that help to assess the use of system resources. This file is generated by the **rrdfssetup(8)** script during installation. It contains an aspect for each file system type on the system. For SLES system, there is usually an BTRFS graph for the root file system and an XFS graph for all the other file systems. Ubuntu systems usually come with only an ext4 graph for file systems of type ext4. The graphs are not different for the different file system types, the main reason for separating them is to prevent overcrowding of the graphs.

The graphs show the portion of a of a file system actually used by files.
